

Pierre Hage-Boutros had a dream to open his own deli, serve the people of the community and bring them to-

gether. Pierre acted on that dream and bought the Old Butler, a small deli and general grocery store. In 1990, he opened Pierre's Deli. He then realized he could better accommodate his guests by adding a restaurant. So in August 1995 to the Spring of 1996, Pierre added a total of four rooms to complete his restaurant.

In late 1996, Pierre further expanded his establishment, purchasing the property adjacent to the deli and restaurant. In early 1997, he started construction on the bakery. Later that year he opened the bakery, an ideal addition that went well with the deli and restaurant.

In order to better serve the community, Pierre moved his deli from the restaurant and connected it to the bakery in 2001. Pierre then completely renovated his restaurant and added a bar and banquet facility including five banquet rooms. Pierre's dream all along was to bring together under one roof, his restaurant, bar, and banquet facilities. The Deli and Bakery now jointly occupy a separate building complete with table or take-out service. He is continuing the tradition of growth and service by opening the elegant LeBebe Restaurant in North Brunswick with his son, Tony.

At Pierre's it's all about making the impossible, possible. In order to accomplish anything in life you need hard work, determination, and a strong belief system. That is the picture created when you walk into the establishment. It was not modeled after a corporate idea but one man's vision for a future for his family. A passion of his, that continues to grow strong every day.

David Sarnoff Award for Advocacy and Community Engagement

Jack is originally from Hunan, China. He worked as an English teacher from July 1987 to August 1992. After that, he worked as an import & export specialist for Nestle for five

years, then for six years as the Procurement Director for Foster Wheeler Inc., an American company with headquarters in Clinton, NJ.

Jack purchased the WAC in 2014, making a \$21 million capital investment, after its prior owner determined that the club, which was exclusively a gym at that time, was no longer profitable. Jack purchased the WAC not as a monetary investment but to provide the community with a unique venue that could serve as community center, recreation center, and gym. At the time, West Windsor had no community center where residents could meet for community events, network for business events, or simply relax and socialize. Under Jack's leadership, the WAC fills all of those needs.

It is far more than just a gym. The WAC hosts numerous events, such as the West Windsor Farmers Market in the winter months, a Family Day for all of West Windsor, and it serves as the meeting place for numerous organizations, such as BNI Tigers and the West Windsor Democrats.

The WAC also fulfills the athletic and recreation needs of its 1200 members, many of whom have family memberships. The WAC partners with many outside vendors to provide its members with unique opportunities, from a basketball league organized by Monroe Sports Center, to swim teams for kids, to a summer camp and college counseling and tutoring. It is truly a unique place that is beloved not only by its members but the entire community.

Jack moved from Vancouver, Canada to Princeton NJ in 2009. He and his wife have two amazing children – my daughter Vanessa, who is a senior at Harvard College; and my son Edward, who is in the 6th Grade at Princeton Charter School.

Christina believes in the American dream to pursue opportunities and to achieve success and prosperity through hard work, determination, and initiative.






